The Peach Days Parade is certainly the highlight of our Event. We would like to thank you for your participation.

The Committee would like to encourage all Commercial entries to be creative in their design.

The more creative - the more attention your entry will receive by the spectators.

Because this is one of the longest parades in Utah our space and time are limited, so this year the Committee is limiting commercial entries to one vehicle per entry.

If you choose to have more than one vehicle you will need to submit two applications and two entry fees.

Decorated floats will be judged at 9:00 a.m. Please have your float parked in its assigned location.

Five awards will be given, Sweepstakes, Most Peachy (Float that best describes the theme), Best Commercial, Chairman's Choice, and Most Creative/Imaginative. Plaque or Trophy awards will be given at the Parade.

A cash award will be mailed to the winning entries within 2 weeks after Peach Days.

All horse or livestock entries must pay the cleanup fee. A honey wagon will be provided by parade committee.

Please register EARLY! No late registrations will be accepted!

No registrations will be accepted after August 10, 2010

The parade committee determines placement of entries. Once a placement assignment has been made, changes cannot be made. Please make copies of the rules/guidelines and application for your own records.

No application will be accepted without a signed release and waiver.

PLEASE READ RULES AND WAIVER AND SIGN FORM!

I agree that I have read and understand the entire application for entry as a participant in the 2010 Peach Days parade, including the set forth rules for the parade. I agree that as a participant, I will fully comply with the rules for the parade. I understand that the Brigham City Police Department and the Parade officials will monitor compliance with said rules. I understand that any violation of such rules may cause my participation in the parade to be immediately terminated. I agree that should I be notified of the termination of my participation by the Police Department or the parade officials, I will follow their directions immediately and peacefully. I agree to assume all liability and to hold Brigham City Corporation and the Brigham City Area Chamber of Commerce harmless from all claims resulting from any injuries or damage resulting from my actions, whether such actions constitute violations of said rules or not. I understand that notwithstanding the efforts of the organizers of the 2010 Peach Days parade, hazards to my safety and to the safety of my property may exist. I agree to waive all claims against Brigham City Corporation and The Brigham City Area Chamber of Commerce resulting from any injuries or accidents that may occur to me, including death and any damage to my property.

Peach Days Parade Rules and Guidelines!

Please read and sign the release and waiver on the application. If distributing items to the crowd, please also initial that you understand the consequences of not obeying the rules. The rules will be strictly enforced this year.

There will be no throwing, tossing, or squirting anything (*Signature Required*)

No objects of any kind (candy, toys, balls, water, etc) shall be thrown, tossed, squirted or propelled by any means from any horse, livestock, vehicle, float, motorcycle, four wheeler, bicycle, scooter, skateboard, or any other moving device. If you disobey this rule, you will be removed from the parade at the next available intersection. Also, your organization will not be allowed to participate in future Peach Days Parades.

This is a very serious safety issue. It is very important for the protection of all concerned

- 1) If desired, items or objects previously noted on the application and approved by the Parade Chairman may be handed out by an individual(s) who are walking with the parade entry along the edge of the crowd.
- 2) Conduct of any nature, which would encourage or entice members of the crowd or other spectators to come into the street, is prohibited.
- 3) We ask that you keep no more than 2 car lengths between you and the entry in front of you. This will keep things moving smoothly, avoiding "GAPS" and "SQUISHERS". Try to be aware of this on your own.
- 4) Entries with performing groups may stop to perform only four (4) times on the parade route, and may stop for a period of no longer than fifteen (15) seconds. Such stops may be made only at the following locations: in front of Smiths (approximately 150 South Main), in front of the Chamber of Commerce building, in front of Coldwell Banker (approximately 200 North Main), and, in front of the Bowling Alley (approximately 500 North Main).
- 5) All entries with horses or livestock **MUST PAY** the extra clean-up fee. This is a courtesy for others behind you.
- 6) **The Release and waiver must be signed and dated. Those wanting to distribute items must also initial that they are aware of the consequences of not obeying the rules on distribution of items.**
- 7) All motorized vehicles must require the necessary insurance to be used on public roads and highways.
- 8) Any and all horses, livestock, vehicles, motorcycles, four-wheelers, floats, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and any other moving devices (both motorized and non-motorized) shall be operated only in the street and only in a reasonable and safe manner so as not to endanger the health or safety of any individuals. Safety is our number one concern.
Drivers will obey all laws, regulations, and City ordinances. Drivers MUST be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Please be sure you have qualified drivers.
- 9) The Parade Chairman may impose any additional rules, which he/she may deem necessary for the safe, peaceful, and successful conduct of the parade.
- 10) These parade rules will be strictly monitored and enforced by the Brigham City Police Department and other assigned parade officials. Violation of any of these parade rules may result in immediate removal from the parade and potential civil and/or criminal liability.

Please distribute a copy of these rules and guidelines to those who will be the actual participants in the parade.

Please help us to keep everyone safe and to have an enjoyable parade.

Your parade line up number and instructions will be mailed to you approximately September 1st.
